Faculty awards for engagement with the community, industry and business 2020-2021

To facilitate faculty engagement with the community, industry and business, CES is offering limited release time or professional development funds (at the discretion of the Department Chair), equivalent to a release time (\$4,000) in AY 2020-2021 to tenure/tenure-track faculty within the college.

To receive the "community, industry and business engagement" award, faculty should submit to Department Chair a short application addressing the following:

- 1. Identification of the specific industry the faculty will engage with, including a letter from the company that will support their engagement,
- 2. Commitment that the faculty will be involved with a project during the semester, (preferably) involving at least one PNW student,
- 3. Faculty should help identify an LTL for the course if he/she wants to be released from, otherwise, faculty could use the funds in summer,
- 4. Faculty should not receive payment from the company for the engagement. Any payment for the project should be through a grant or contract with PNW, paying for student time as well as subsidizing the professional development offered to faculty

## Deliverables:

At the end of the semester, it is expected that the faculty submit a brief report to the department chair, stating the outcome of the release time. If a report is submitted to the company as part of the work, a copy provided to the department chair is sufficient.

## Continuation of Release:

To continue receiving the release for a second semester, faculty should bring a minimum of \$5,000 net from a contract/grant from the community, industry or business involving at least one PNW student.

After receiving two release times, faculty should show how he/she integrated the project into his/her classroom teaching, or have a publication related to his/her engagement with industry.
