APPLICATION CHECKLIST

ELIGIBILITY

- 18 or older at the time of application submission
- Citizen or lawful permanent resident of the US
- Able to pass background security clearance required for government employment
- No record of academic misconduct
- Fulltime student during the scholarship period

APPLICATION PACKAGE

Part A (Personal Documents):

Please have the following materials prior to starting the application form

- Up-to-date resume (resume should include the following applicable information: education history, relevant courses, GPA, scholarship, awards, honors, veteran or military status, athletics, prior degrees)
- A personal statement describing your motivation for applying to SFS, interest in cyber security as a profession and readiness to work for the government
- Current transcripts, initially these can be unofficial but official transcripts may be required upon acceptance into the program

Part B (References):

- Download and print 3 copies of the reference form (can be found within the application and on the PNW CyberCorps webpage: <https://www.pnw.edu/cybersecurity/center-for-cybersecurity/scholarships/>)
- Provide 1 form for to each of the 3 references. Remember, one reference must be a professor within the cyber security program
- References will email completed documents to CyberCorps@pnw.edu (deadline: **June 10, 2022**)

Part C (Application):
