Early Childhood was Nationally Recognized Spring 2020 through NAEYC Fall 2019

“The program is recognized through the semester and year noted as in the Recognition Report. The provider may designate its program as Nationally Recognized by NAEYC in its published materials until the status expires. The program will be listed as Nationally Recognized through the semester of the next CAEP accreditation decision on websites and/or other publications of the SPA and CAEP. The institution may designate its program as Nationally Recognized by the SPA, through the semester of the next CAEP accreditation decision, in its published materials.
