

**2021-2022 Verification Worksheet**

Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for a "Verification" process which compares information from your FAFSA with your (and your spouse's, if you are married) 2019 Federal income tax information and/or other financial documents. Based on this review, Purdue University Northwest may need to make electronic corrections to your FAFSA information. Verification must be completed by Sept. 30, 2022 or 120 days after your last day of enrollment for 2021-2022, whichever is earlier. Verification includes receipt of a valid and correct Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR) with an official Expected Family Contribution (EFC). Financial aid will not be disbursed until the verification process is complete.

Federal Law requires Purdue University Northwest to review the requested information under the financial program rule 34CFR, Part 668

**What you should do**

1. Complete, sign and submit this Verification Worksheet.
2. Submit your (and your spouse's) 2019 IRS Tax Return Transcript(s), **if required**, and any other requested documents to the Office of Financial Aid. IRS Tax Return Transcripts may be requested from the IRS on-line at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov) or by calling 1-800-908-9946.
3. If the student and/or spouse, filed or will file, an **Amended** 2019 IRS Tax Return, contact the Office of Financial Aid at Purdue University Northwest.

Note: Deadline for submitting verification information is **September 1, 2022**. Eligibility for financial aid will not be determined until verification is complete.
