University Village Recycling Guide

HOW TO RECYCLE

- University Village will now have a pick-up recycling program. You will be able to place your special recycling bags outside of your apartment and facilities staff will come by to pick it up during the designated recycling times.
 Housing will provide bags at Peregrine and Griffin service desk
- This service is **ONLY** for recycling. Any trash that is found will be considered an unauthorized disposal of trash and may lead to disciplinary actions through the conduct system.
 - o *If you are not aware of what you can recycle please see WHAT TO RECYCLE section.

RECYLING PICK-UP WINDOW

- Recycling will ONLY be picked up on Thursdays from 10:00am-11:30am. All recycling bags need to be placed out before 10:00am on Thursdays (Earliest set our time will be Wednesday night after 10:00pm).
- Please place your recycling bags neatly in the entry way of your apartment
 - Do not place recycling in the main hallway.
 - If your recycling bag is not a housing supplied recycling bag it will not be picked up and you will be responsible for disposing of your items. *Documentation may occur*



WHERE TO GET RECYCLING BAG

- Residents are able to pick up the special recycling bags located at the front desk
 of Griffin Hall between the hours of 8am and 2am each day (except Holidays).
 Only these bags will be collected during the recycling times.
 - o Please note these are special bags and regular plastic bags cannot be used at a substitute.

WHAT TO RECYCLE

- All paper, including high-grade office paper, magazines, and newspaper can be mixed together.
- Glass (please make sure that it does not puncture the recycling bag).
- Cans made of aluminum, tin, and steel are acceptable. Rinse containers.
- Remove debris from boxes (e.g., packing peanuts or pizza crusts from frozen pizzas). <u>Flatten</u> and place boxes by apartment entry way during pick-up time if it cannot fit inside recycling bag.
- Plastic bottles that are PETE (#1) and HDPE (#2) are acceptable. (Such numbers are noted on the bottom of containers.) Rinse containers. It eliminates contaminants in the recycling process. Remove and throw away lids.
- No plastic shopping bags, please!

WHAT WE WILL NOT RECYCLE

Paper and Cardboard

Hardcover books, napkins, paper towels, tissues, paper soiled with food or liquid, paper with a lot of tape and glue, plastic-or wax-coated paper, photographic paper, frozen food containers, NO TAKE-OUT OR DELIVERY pizza boxes.

Metal, Glass and Plastic

Styrofoam, plastic bags, shower curtains, containers that held dangerous or corrosive chemicals, lighters, plastic tubes (toothpaste, lotion, and cosmetics), single-serve food and drink squeezable pouches, VHS or cassette tapes, pens, disposable razors, 3-ring binders, umbrellas, garden hoses, luggage, sponges, sports balls, mirrors, plate glass, light bulbs, ceramics, glassware, batteries, electronics, extension cords, diapers
