

Restricted Persons/Parties Screening (RPS) Request Form

Purdue University's Office of Research Integrity and Regulatory Affairs will perform "Restricted Persons/Parties Screening" (RPS) for Purdue University activities. The screening process searches a number of restricted persons lists maintained by federal agencies. These lists identify persons (individuals and companies) convicted of export control violations related to the Export Administration Regulations (EAR), the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR), and/or transactions sanctioned by The US Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC). It is illegal to provide export controlled data and/or services to individuals and companies on the restricted lists. The office works diligently to ensure that no one is improperly denied access to education or work.
