This report contains billing hour breakouts and headcounts. The campus code on each course determines if the billing hours should go under 'General Fund', 'Academic Outreach' or 'Dual Credit'. Courses with a campus code of 'PUC' or 'PNC' are counted as 'General Fund'. Courses with a campus of 'NCN', 'NCP', 'CCN', 'CCP' are counted under 'Dual Concurrent'. Courses with a campus code beginning with 'N' or 'C' (other than the Dual Credit courses) are counted under 'Academic Outreach'. Additionally, if a student has a student attribute of 'INDS', 'IN15', or 'IN20' all of their courses are counted under 'Academic Outreach'. 'Type of Student' breaks out students into 3 types: 'On-Line Programs'-Students in the on-line Nursing Program, 'High School Student'-Students currently in High school who are taking PNW sponsored college level courses at their High School or are taking courses at one of the campuses, 'Core Students'-All students except for 'On-Line Programs' and 'High School Students'. The total billing hours for Academic Outreach and Contract Training (AOCT) is the sum of billing hours for 'Acad Outreach' and 'Dual Credit'. A course is included if the registration status is ('RE', 'RW') and there are either Course or Billing hours. Full-Time / Part-Time: Undergrads - 12 billing hours, Grads - 9 billing hours.
