Dr. Powell's research focuses on family, education, gender, and sexuality. He has examined how families confer advantages (or disadvantages) to their children and how family structure influences parental investments in children with grants from the National Science Foundation, American Education Research Association, and the Spencer Foundation. He is especially interested in several increasingly visible groups of "atypical" family forms: families with older parents, bi/multiracial families, adoptive families, and gay/lesbian families.
