

## **PNW STUDENT CONFERENCE PRESENTATION GRANTS**

### **APPLY HERE**

The Student Conference Presentation Grant is available to support undergraduate and graduate students to present their research or projects at conferences or competitions. The maximum funding is \$400 for a presentation or competition, subject to funding availability. Students and faculty mentors should read the following guidelines before applying.

- Students must be registered for classes and in good academic standing to apply.
- Only students are eligible for the Student Conference Presentation Grant. Funds cannot be used to support faculty.
- Total grant will not exceed \$400 for individual or multi-student presentations.
- The grant will be used to cover conference registration and other eligible expenses. The student's department will work with Business Office regarding the payment and/or reimbursement. Students will not receive cash.
- Grant funds can be used for the following expenses:
  - Conference registration
  - PNW – approved travel expenses (e.g. hotel, mileage, etc.)
  - Materials and supplies necessary for presentation
- Students who receive the grant must agree to present their research at the PNW Days of Discovery in April of 2024.
- To apply, please make sure to have the following information ready:
  1. First and Last Name
  2. PNW Email
  3. Are you an undergraduate or graduate student?
  4. Department and Major
  5. Faculty Mentor's Name and PNW Email
  6. Will your mentor also attend the conference?
  7. Name, website, and location of the conference
  8. Date and Title of your presentation
  9. Abstract of the paper/presentation (250 words max.)
  10. Registration, invitation, or presentation acceptance letter has to be attached.
  11. Estimated cost broken down by category (e.g. registration, travel, materials)
  12. Is your department or college providing any support?
  13. Signed email or letter from your faculty mentor supporting your participation at the conference has to be attached.
