# Gene Stratton Porter Hall (PORT) First Floor

## Building Text Description

### Building Location:

Gene Stratton Porter Hall (PORT) is located on the north side of the Hammond campus, west of the 169<sup>th</sup> St. Parking Garage, south of the 169<sup>th</sup> Street Parking lot, northeast of the Student Union & Library Building, east of the Gyte Building, and north of 171<sup>st</sup> Street.

### Entrances:

There are five (5) entrances into PORT. There is pavement leading up to all of these entrances.

- The **North Entrance** (E1) leads into the north end of the west hallway next to the north stairway.
  - This entrance is ADA accessible.
  - This entrance has two sets of double doors separated by a vestibule (1H01).
- The **West Entrance** (E2) leads into the lobby, which leads into the west hallway and the south hallway.
  - This entrance is ADA accessible.
  - There are two double door exterior entrances leading into the vestibule.
  - This entrance is sets of double doors separated by a vestibule (1H05).
- The **East Entrance** (E3) leads into the east end of the south hallway, next to the east stairway.
  - This is a double door entrance.
  - This entrance is ADA accessible.
- The **Northeast Entrance** (E4) leads into the TV Studio through a double door entrance.
- The **Mechanical Entrance** (E5) leads into a maintenance room.

### Elevators:

There is one (1) elevator in PORT. The elevator (1E01) is located off of the south hallway near the intersection with the west hallway.

### Stairs:

There are two (2) stairways in PORT.

- The **North Stairway** (1S02) is located at the north end of the west hallway.
- The **East Stairway** (1S01) is located at the east end of the south hallway.

### Restrooms:

There is one set of public restrooms on the first floor of PORT, located off of the south hallway near the elevator. These restrooms have stalls, and are ADA accessible.

- The **Women's Restroom** is room 111.
- The **Men's Restroom** is room 115.

### Building layout (hallways & open areas):

There are three (3) hallways and one (1) open area on the first floor of PORT.

- The **Lobby** (1H04) is a rectangular open area which connects the west entrance to the corner of both the west hallway and the south hallway.
- The **West Hallway** (1H02) runs north to south, connecting with the north entrance, the north stairway, the south hallway, and the lobby.
- The **South Hallway** (1H03) runs west to east, connecting with the west hallway, the lobby, the east stairway, and the east entrance.
- The **Radio Hallway** (room 119) connects to the south hallway at both ends, separated by single doors opening into the south hallway. The hallway runs parallel to the south hallway.

### Room Locations:

- Rooms 100 – 108 are located off of the west hallway in ascending order north to south.
- The **FLL Language Lab** is room 100, located off of the west hallway, with two single door entrances.
- The **Mail Room** is 109, located off of the south hallway near the connection to the west hallway.
- The **Lounge** is room 110, located off of the lobby through a single door entrance.
- Rooms 109 and 111 – 122 are located off of the south hallway in ascending order west to east.
- Rooms 119A – 119K are located off of the radio hallway in ascending order, going clockwise starting at the west end of the hallway.
- The **Radio Studio** is room 119B, located off of the radio hallway.
- The **Radio Control Room** is 119C, located off of the radio hallway.
- The **Viewing Room** is 119D, located off of the radio hallway.
- **Radio/TV Maintenance** is room 119E, located off of the radio hallway.
- **The TV Control Room** is 119F, located off of the radio hallway.
- **Video Editing** is rooms 119H and 119K, located off of the radio hallway.
- The **TV Studio** is room 121, located off of the south hallway through a double door entrance, as well as the northeast entrance, and a single door entrance from room 119G, which leads into the radio hallway.
