Gene Stratton Porter Hall (PORT) Second Floor

Building Text Description

Building Location:

Gene Stratton Porter Hall (PORT) is located on the north side of the Hammond campus, west of the 169th St. Parking Garage, south of the 169th Street Parking lot, northeast of the Student Union & Library Building, east of the Gyte Building, and north of 171st Street.

Entrances:

There are five (5) entrances into PORT, and all of them are located on the first floor. To access the second floor there are two (2) stairways and one (1) elevator that lead onto this floor.

Elevators:

There is one (1) elevator in PORT. The elevator (2E01) is located off of the south hallway near the intersection with the west hallway.

Stairs:

There are two (2) stairways in PORT.

- The **North Stairway** (2S02) is located at the north end of the west hallway.
- The **East Stairway** (2S01) is located at the east end of the south hallway.

Restrooms:

There is one set of public restrooms on the second floor of PORT, located at the corner of the south hallway and the west hallway. These restrooms have stalls, and are ADA accessible.

- The **Women's Restroom** is room 212.
- The **Men's Restroom** is room 208.

Building layout (hallways & open areas):

There are two (2) hallways on the second floor of PORT.

- The **West Hallway** (2H01) runs north to south, connecting with the north stairway and the south hallway.
- The **South Hallway** (2H02) runs west to east, connecting to the west hallway and the east stairway.

Room Locations:

- Rooms 200 – 206 are located off of the west hallway in ascending order north to south.
- The **PSY Research Lab** is room 206, located off of the west hallway in the corner connected to the south hallway.

- Rooms 207 – 224 are located off of the south hallway in ascending order west to east.
- The **Computer Learning Center** is room 222, located off of the south hallway, with two single door entrances into the room; the eastern entrance into the room has stairs leading into the room.
