

Student Union and Library Building (PWRS) First Floor

Building Text Description

Building Location:

The Student Union and Library Building (SULB) is located in the north central part of the Hammond campus, west of Ontario Ave., southeast of the Gyte Building, southwest of Porter Hall, north of North 173rd Street Parking and just east of the Peregrine Path.

Entrances:

There are nine (9) entrances into SULB on the first floor.

- The **North Entrance** (C1) leads into the north end of the main west hallway and the main east hallway, next to the main stairway.
 - This entrance is ADA accessible.
 - There are six (6) interior and exterior doors separated by a vestibule (1H05).
- The **Northwest Entrance** (C2) leads into the northwest stairway and the student lounge, room 100.
 - This entrance is ADA accessible.
 - This entrance has two sets of double doors separated by a vestibule (1S04).
- The **Southwest Entrance** (C5) leads into the south end of the main west hallway.
 - This entrance is ADA accessible.
 - There are two interior and exterior sets of double doors separated by a vestibule (1H03).
- The **Southeast Entrance** (C6) leads into the south end of the main east hallway.
 - This entrance is ADA accessible.
 - There are two interior and exterior sets of double doors separated by a vestibule (1H04).
- The **West Receiving Entrance** (C3) leads into the receiving room. There are stairs onto a loading dock leading to this entrance.
- The **Bookstore Receiving Entrance** (C4) leads into the bookstore storage room. There are stairs onto a loading dock leading to this entrance.
- The **East Entrance** (C7) leads into the east hallway through double doors. There is a ramp onto a loading dock leading to this entrance.
- The **Northeast Entrance** leads into the dining area, room 150D.
- The **North Central Entrance** leads into Calumet Room/the Conference Room, 150F.

Elevators:

There are three (3) elevators in SULB.

- The **West Elevator** (1E01) is located off of the student lounge, just south of the northwest entrance.
- The **East Elevator** (1E02) is located off of vending, which is off of the dining area.
- The **North Elevator** (1E03) is located off of the north end of the main west hallway.

Stairs:

There are four (4) stairways in SULB.

- The **Main Stairway** (1S02) is located at the north central intersection of the main west hallway and the main east hallway, just south of the north entrance.
- The **Northwest Stairway** (1S04) is located in the northwest corner of the student lounge through a set of double doors. It also connects to the northwest entrance.
- The **South Stairway** (1S01) is located at the south end of the main west hallway, near the southwest entrance, through a set of double doors.
- The **East Stairway** (1S03) is located at the west end of the east hallway, next to the dining area, through a single door.

Restrooms:

There is one set of public restrooms on the first floor of SULB, located off of the main west hallway.

- The **Women's Restroom** is room 123.
- The **Men's Restroom** is room 122.

Building layout (hallways & open areas):

There are three (3) hallways and two (2) open areas on the first floor of SULB.

- The **Student Lounge**, room 100, is an open area located off of the main west hallway through two sets of double doors and off of the northwest entrance and the northwest stairway through double doors. The Student Lounge also connects to the west elevator, and rooms 106, 104A and 104B.
- The **South Lounge**, room 125A, is an open area located at the southern intersection between the main east hallway and the main west hallway, between the southwest entrance and the southeast entrance, across from room 125.
- The **Main West Hallway** (1H01) runs north to south, connecting with the southwest entrance, the south stairway, the south lounge, the north entrance and the main stairway.
- The **Main East Hallway** (1H02) runs north to south, connecting with the southeast entrance, the south lounge, the north entrance and the main stairway.
- The **East Hallway** (154) runs west to east, connecting with the east entrance, the dining area and the kitchen.

Room Locations:

- Rooms 100 and 110 are located off of the main west hallway in ascending order north to south.
- The **Student Lounge** is room 100, located off of the main west hallway through two sets of double doors and the northwest entrance through double doors. Rooms 101, 103 and 105 are located off of this room.
- Rooms 104 – 106 are located off of the student lounge and northwest entrance.
- The **Billiard Room** is 105, located off of the student lounge.
- The **Bookstore** is room 110, located off of the main west hallway through two sets of double doors opening into the hallway. Room 114 is off of the bookstore.
- Room 114 is located off of the bookstore and off of the bookstore receiving entrance.
- Rooms 120 – 125 are located off of the main west hallway in ascending order north to south.
- Rooms 150 – 150F are located off of the main east hallway in ascending order south to north.
- The **Public and Private Dining Areas** are in rooms 150, 150D, 150E, and the **Region Room Dining** is in room 150C. These are all located off of the main east hallway, with room 150D connecting to the northeast entrance, the Region Room Dining connecting to the east hallway, and room 150 connecting to both Vending, room 170, and the Food Serving Area, room 180, through two sets of double doors.
- The **Calumet Room/the Conference Room** is 150F, located off of the north end of the main east hallway through a double door, and the north central entrance.
- Rooms 156 – 170 are located off of the east hallway in ascending order going clockwise, starting at the west end of the hallway.
- **Vending** is in room 170, located off of the dining area and the east hallway next to room 184.
- Rooms 180, 184 and 186 are located in the southeast corner of the building, all three connected to each other. Room 184 connects to the east hallway and room 180 connects to the dining area, room 150.
- The **Food Serving Area** is room 180, located in the southeast corner of the building, connecting to the dining area, room 150, and rooms 184 and 186.
